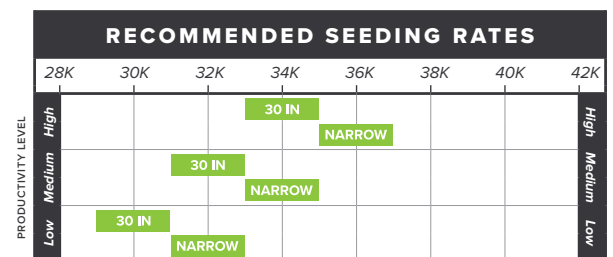
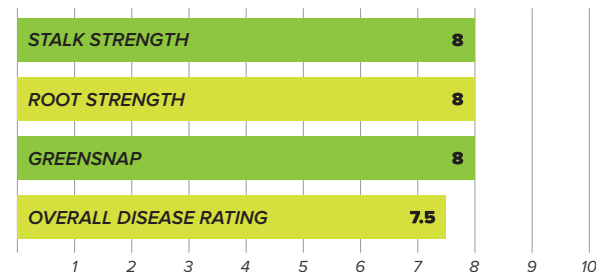
- HR** **Light Soils:** Low O.M., Low CEC, Low water holding capacity.
- HR** **Medium Soils:** O.M. 1.5-3.5%, CEC 11-20, Good productivity, well drained silt loams.
- HR** **Heavy Soils:** High O.M. >3.5%, CEC >20, Well drained highly productive with deep top soil
- R** **Poorly Drained Soils:** Soils that tend to remain saturated for extended periods of time.

AREA OF ADAPTATION

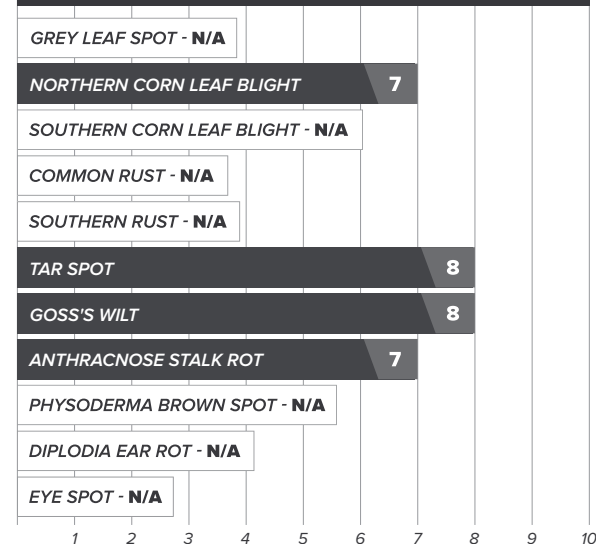
- HR** **Western:** West of Mississippi River
- HR** **Central:** I-35 to I-65
- HR** **Eastern:** East of Mississippi River
- HR** Moves South well for an early season hybrid
- HR** Moves North well for a full season hybrid
